

## THE WOMAN'S BIBLE & THE WOMEN'S BIBLE COMMENTARY

Convinced that society's repression of women was a direct result of the centuries-long teachings of Judeo-Christian orthodoxy (which held women's creation to be an afterthought), Elizabeth Cady Stanton hoped that women would use the vote to effect social change and end their subordina-

tion. When she saw the suffrage movement being taken over by religiously orthodox women, she fought back with a radical act, the publication in 1895 of The Woman's Bible. This book presents modern translations, alongside enlightening commentaries, of the approximately 10% of texts in the Bible that reference women. Though censured by the National American Woman Suffrage Association, of which Elizabeth had been president, the book won a popular and worldwide readership. As a political treatise, its publication was a call to action; in its centenary, it is still an extraordinary document. In 1992 The Women's Bible Commentary was published as a forum for renowned women scholars to present feminist biblical interpretations, illumined by a century of biblical criticism. ~ JFL
